ALLEN & WHEELOCK was one of the first manufactures in the U.S.A. They produced cartridges from 1857 until they became the ETHAN ALLEN in 1866, thus making them probably the second .22 manufacturer after SMITH &WESSON.

- S-l .22 No.1 PISTOL. "100 No. 30 CARTRIDGES". Black label with gold printing. Orange and black mottled, two-piece, half-split box. Black side sealing label with no printing. No product code. Lead bullet. No h/s on a copper case.
- S-2 <u>.22 No.1 PISTOL.</u> "100 No. 30 CARTRIDGES". Same as S-1, except CARTRIDGES is in a different style of type and has a comma in place of a period behind the word. Variations noted:
 - (a) No h/s on a copper case.
 - (b) "AW-l" h/s on a copper case.
- S-3 .22 No.1 PISTOL. "100 No. 3 CARTRIDGES". Same as S-2, except reads No. 3. on top label

"A&W-1" h/s

Note: No.3O is the ALLEN & WHEELOCK code for .22 cartridges.
