

ETHAN ALLEN

Worcester, MA

This manufacturer originally was THE ALLEN & WHEELLOCK CO. until Wheelock died in 1864. For the remainder of that year Ethan Allen operated the business alone as ETHAN ALLEN. In 1865 he took his two sons-in-laws into the business and changed the name once again to Ethan Allen & Co. Until his death in 1871. The business then became FOREHAND & WADSWORTH.

S-1 .22 SHORT. "No. 30 CARTRIDGES". 100 rounds. Black label with gold printing on black mottled, two-piece, half-split box. Similar to S-1 but No. 30 called out at top of box instead of No. 22. Early Ethan Allen boxes referred to No. 30 as .22s. Also no "& Co." after name. Contents unknown.
