Hosea Lombard produced this box for the .22 James Warner Revolver. His company survived for only two years because he was called to service as a captain of F Company of the 10th Massachusetts regiment in 1862

Lombard produced these rim fire cartridges in a distinctive manner and is the only manufacturer to leave a solid line tool mark in the base of the case, parallel to the diameter but closer to the rim. On some specimens the line is broken if the case is slightly concave.
