


This early producer had their offices at the foot of West 52th street in New York City. They were incorporated in New York on March 17, 1865 with a capitalization of \$200,000. This company was set up by Fitch, Van Vechten & Co as a continuation of their older manufacturing operation. The extent of their sales and production are not known at this time. They closed this business during 1867
