
SMITH, HALL & FARMER

Smith, Hall and Farmer was the first of several companies. This version lasted from 1865 to 1866 and specialized in pistol cartridges. It was changed to Smith, Hall and Buckland in 1866 to 1869 and was later sold to Hall & Hubbard in 1869 These other two companies are also represented in the Dunn catalo but not this one.

- S-1 .22 SHORT. "100 No. 1 PISTOL CARTRIDGES". Green label with black printing on a black mottled, two-piece box. Contents unknown.
- S-2 .22 SHORT. "100 No. 1 PISTOL CARTRIDGES". Same as S-1 but slightly different format to label. Contents unknown.
