Stembridge Gun rentals of Hollywood, California, was formed in about 1920 by James Stembridge and Cecil B. DeMille to supply guns to the movie industry. They are still in business.

The Stembridge boxes are labels pasted onto miscellaneous .22 boxes and non-.22 boxes. The flash powder blanks were available in many calibers but we will concentrate only on the .22 rimfire versions.. An assortment is shown. It's felt that individual descriptions are unnecessary.

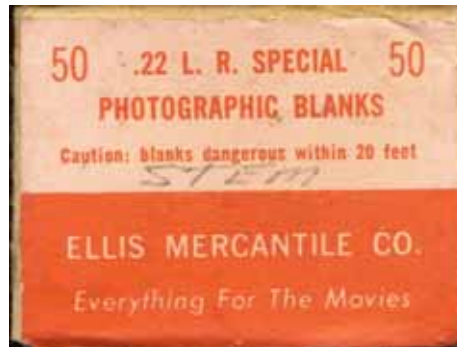

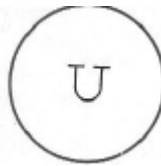
